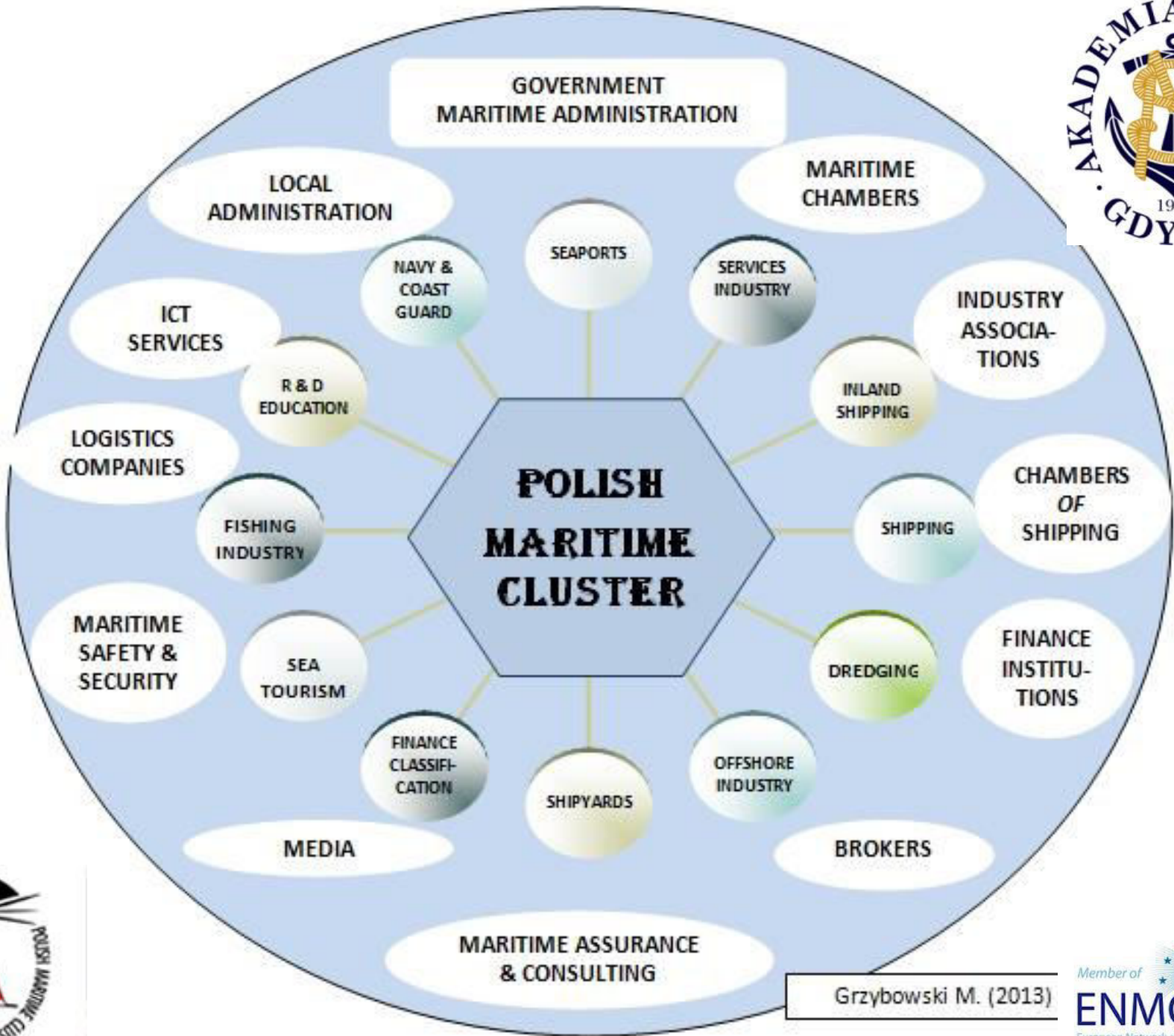

W dniach 6-7 listopada odbyła się w Malmö konferencja pt. "Get smarter together in the Baltic Sea Region - taking innovation and smart specialisation across borders". Ze strony Akademii Morskiej w Gdyni i Polskiego Klastra Morskiego wzięli w niej udział uczestnicy projektu MARCHAIN/STARDUST: prof. Marek Grzybowski, dr Arkadiusz Mazurkiewicz, dr Michał Igielski, dr Magda Leszczyna-Rzucidło, mgr Marta Czarnecka-Gallas.

W trakcie konferencji prezentowano wyniki wspólnych działań badawczych i wdrożeniowych realizowanych w ramach projektu STARDUST. Obejmował on 5 projektów, wśród których istotne znaczenie odgrywał projekt MARCHAIN, w ramach którego pracownicy Akademii Morskiej wypracowali 2 projekty i wiele działań promujących Region Morza Bałtyckiego. Jednym z projektów opracowanym z partnerami z MARCHAIN jest "BSR-COR". Jego podstawowym celem jest wykreowanie w regionie intermodalnych korytarzy transportowych. Drugim projektem jest "Baltic Promise", którego celem jest opracowanie jednolitego standardu CSR dla MSP w Regionie Morza Bałtyckiego. Pracownicy AM Gdynia promowali Region Morza Bałtyckiego na Europejskim Dniu Morza 2013, na rocznym spotkaniu European Network of Maritime Clusters oraz Intermodal Europe 2013. Zespół z Polski podjął również inicjatywę zbudowania sieci klastrów morskich Regionu Morza Bałtyckiego.

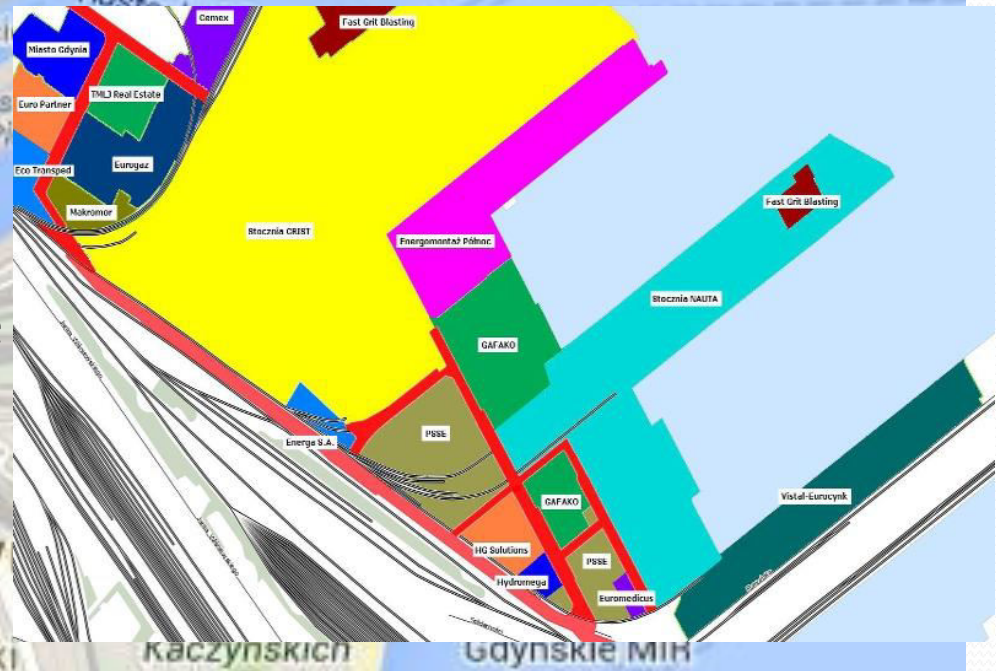
Pomeranian Special Economic Zone (PSEZ)

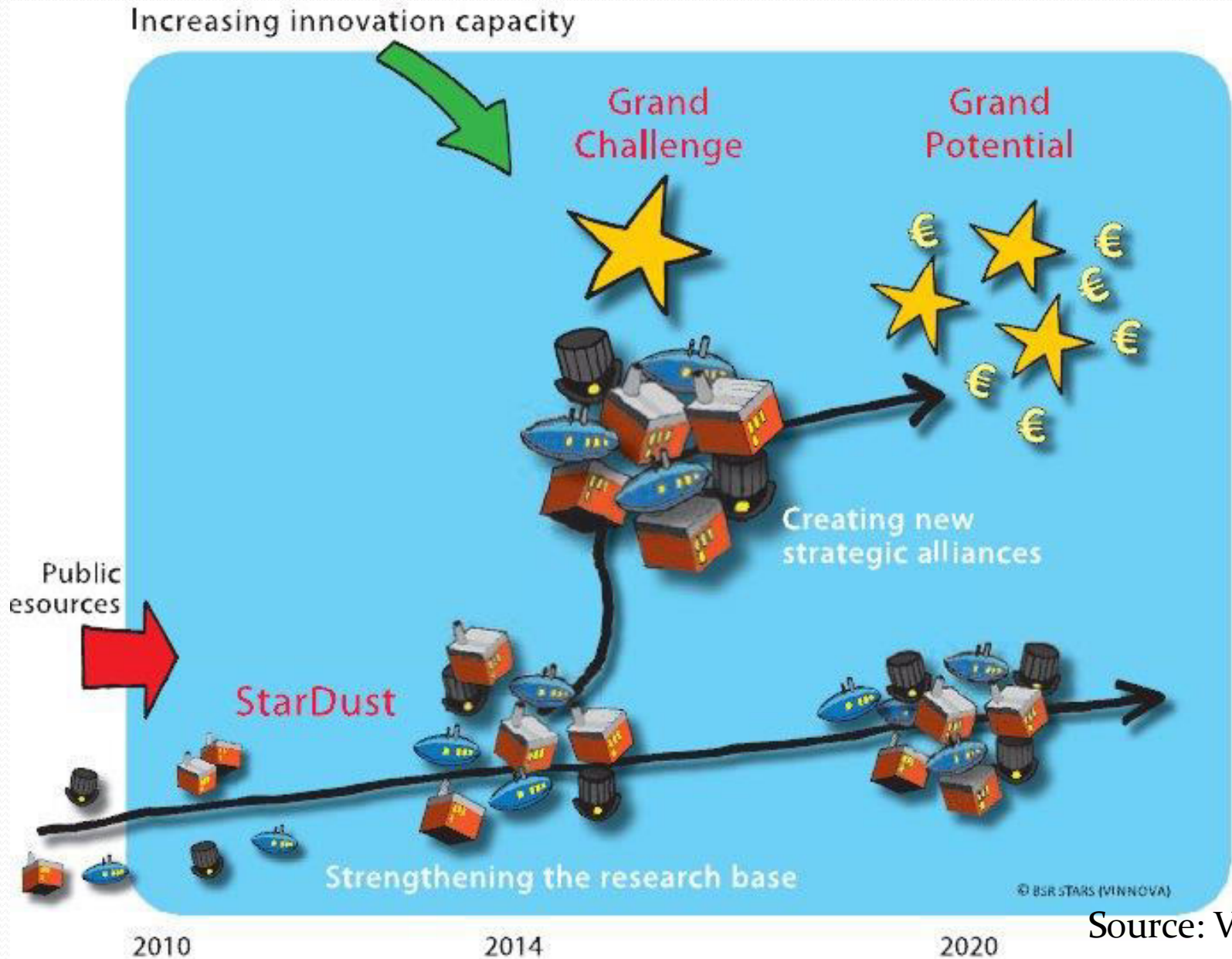

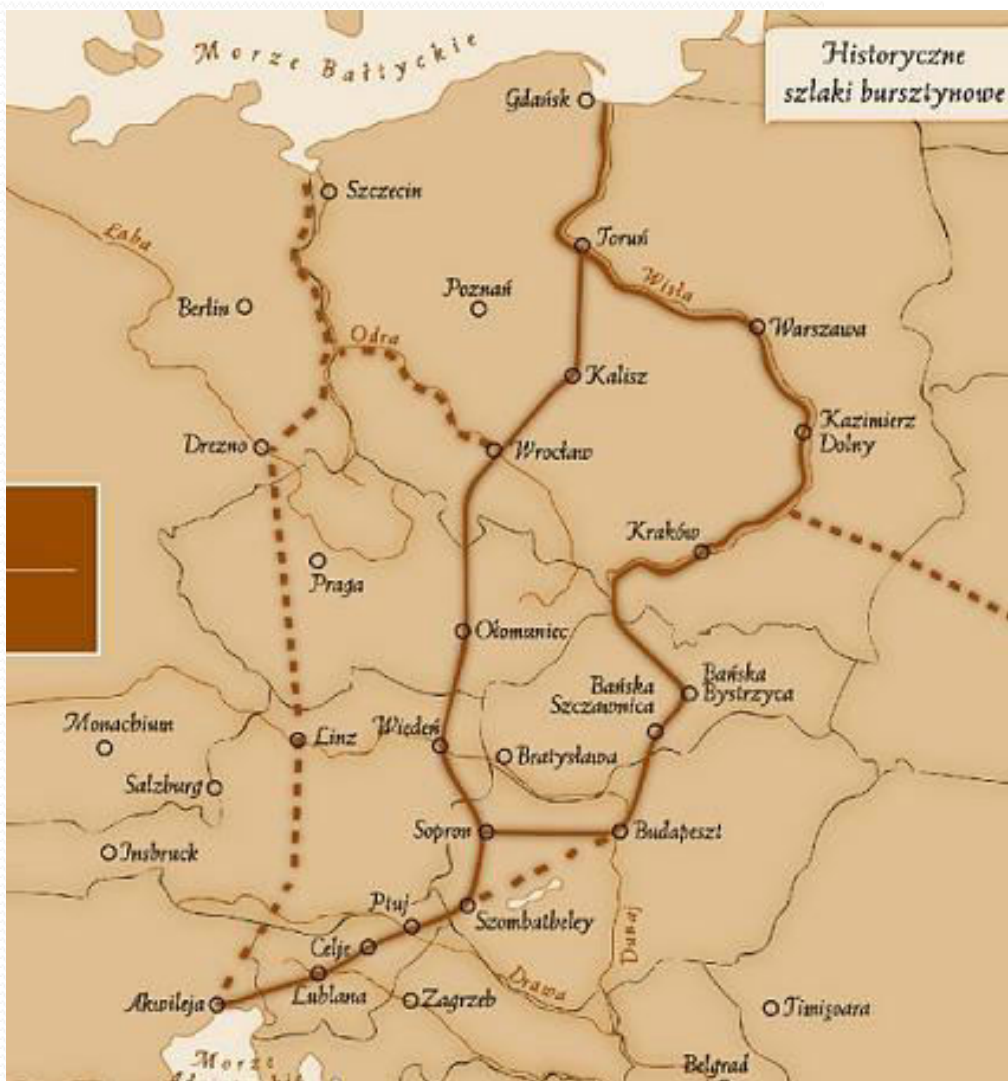

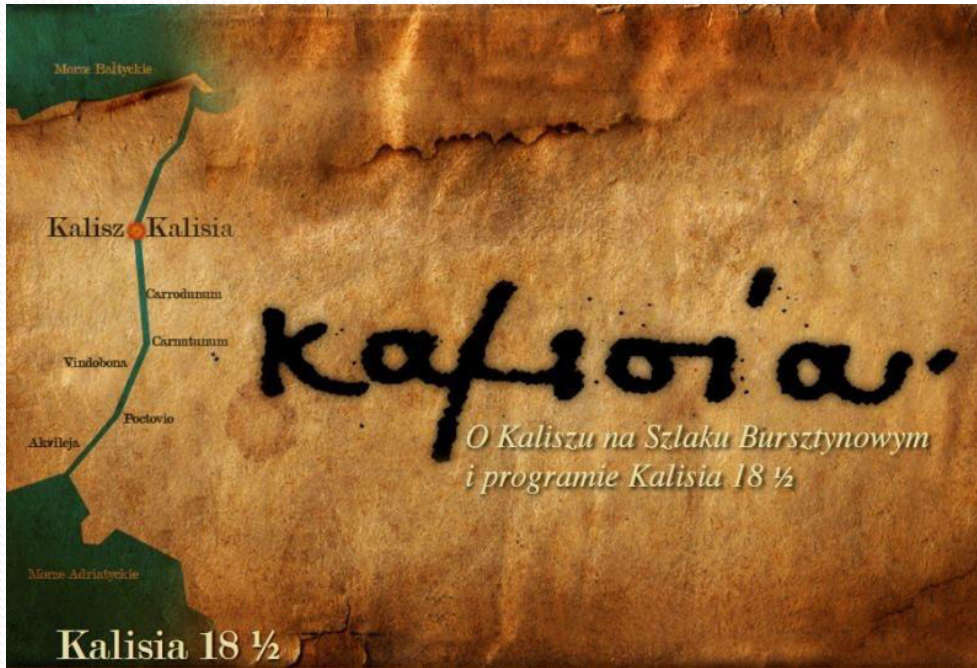

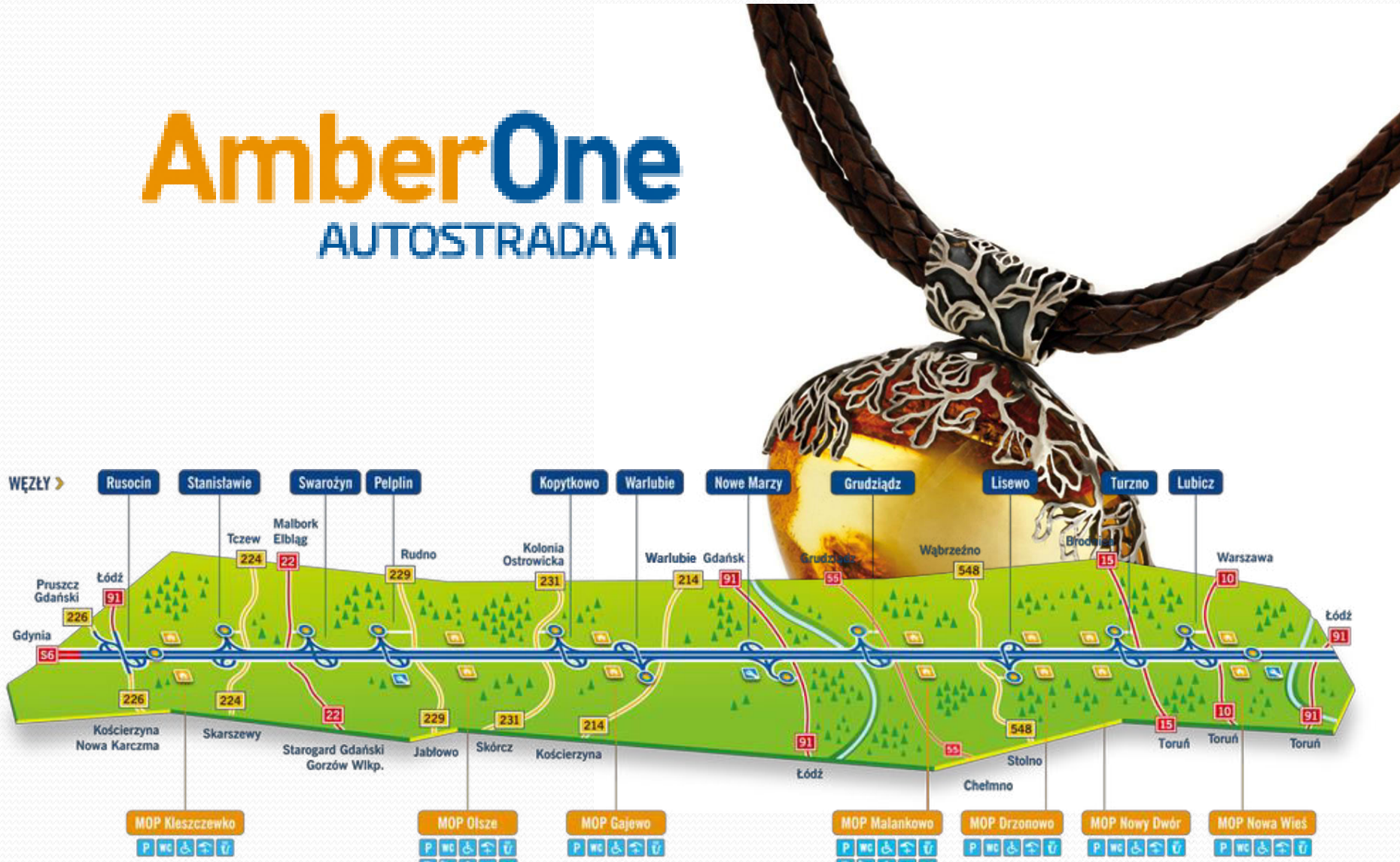

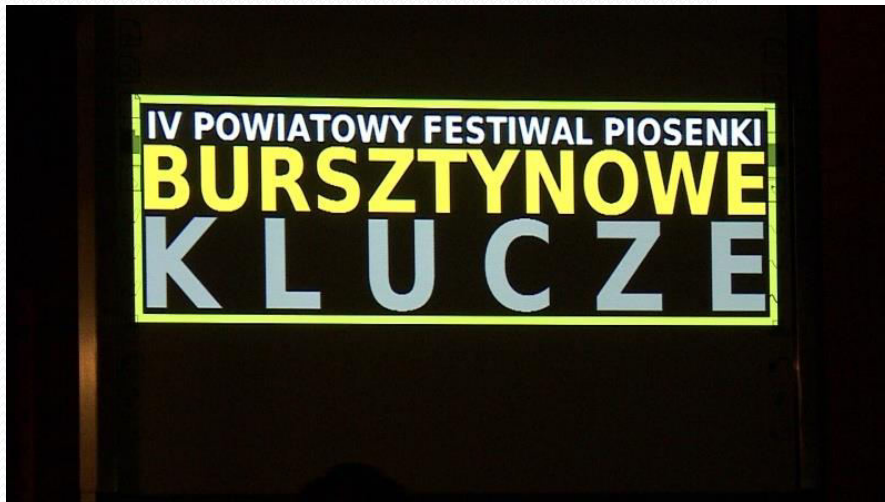
